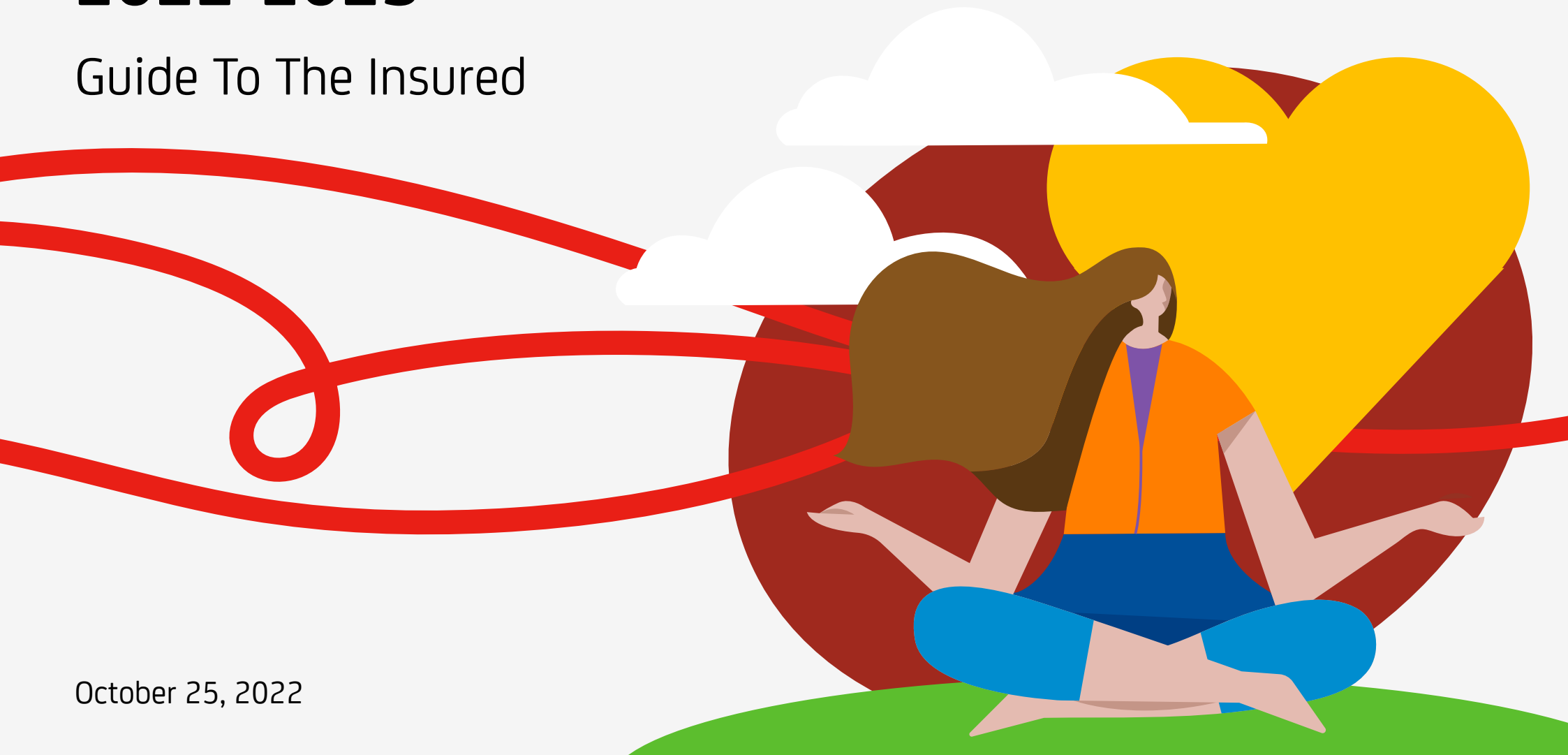

Campaign Description

Uni.C.A. launched the **Prevention Campaign for the year 2022-2023**, consisting of free check-ups accessible to its members

The check-up protocols, divided by sex and age groups¹, are functional to verify the main oncological and cardiovascular risk factors and to early detection of any .

A new element of this Preventive Campaign is the addition of tests normally linked to delicate phases of life, such as menopause and andropause: they are blood tests, including hormonal ones, and radiological tests, such as mammography and femoral bone densitometry. These assessments are explained in the protocols listed below and their execution will take place together with the other scheduled examinations and assessments.

Recipients of the prevention campaign are Uni.C.A. members, **insured persons in service, retired or retired, with the exception of employees and retirees who have the check-up guarantee already provided for in the policy (FVP, SVP, EVP & above executives and their spouses / cohabitants more uxorio included in the coverage.)**; moreover, the Campaign is open to spouses / cohabitants more uxorio of the aforementioned Owners as long as they are also employees or pensioners of the Group (or of the external companies belonging to Uni.C.A.) included in the coverage of the Owner.

¹ To be understood as referring to the date of September 30, 2022.

The Campaign is made up of two phases (three, for those who are at least 60 years old and for heavy smokers):

- the first phase, relating to the provision of laboratory tests;
- the second phase, relating to the provision of specialist medical examinations and image diagnostics;
- the third phase (on request)², relating to the provision of colonoscopy with sedation for those who are at least 60 years old, the chest CT scan for “heavy smokers” and transrectal prostatic ultrasound for men who are at least 60 years old years.

² where there is an indication from the cardiologist or oncologist based on the findings in the second phase.



The period for carrying out the check ups is as follows: **from 25 October 2022 to 31 July 2023**. Reservations will be allowed **by 30.06.2023**, with no possibility of extensions.

An interruption is foreseen for carrying out the screening in the period 17.12.2022 - 7.1.2023.

(*) some health facilities, limited to radiological services (mammography and femoral MOC), even if performed in the prevention field, have implemented the provisions of Legislative Decree 101/2020 “Fundamental safety standards relating to radiation protection against the dangers deriving from exposure of ionizing radiation” which provides, for the protection of the patients themselves, that the service is prescribed. Therefore, the same structures may request a medical prescription when booking the package. In this regard, we invite interested parties to check with the chosen facility, when booking the health protocol assigned to them, whether or not they need a medical prescription.

(***) if during the colonoscopy with sedation, the removal of polyps is necessary, the structure will activate directly with Previmedical for the rectification of the taking in charge and the removal service will fall within the settlement rules provided for by the reference Health Plan.

(****) only for “heavy smokers” (persons who in their life have smoked a total of more than 1 pack of cigarettes for 30 years).

How To Access Health Services

To perform the health services contained in the 2022-2023 prevention protocols, Patients must:

- Check that you have the requirements to participate in the Prevention Campaign (see previous paragraph);
- **Find the Healthcare Facility of the Previmedical Network** dedicated to the initiative using the “RESEARCH STRUCTURES” function, which can be found within the reserved area of the Previmedical website, in the “PREVENTION” section; the expected path is as follows:
 - **if Employee in service**, via My UniCredit > My Workspace> Welfare UniCredit> Uni.C.A. (icon present in the “red bar” at the top) > Your health plan > **PREVENTION** > RESEARCH STRUCTURES;
 - **for everyone**, through the website www.unica.previmedical.it - Members Area> **PREVENTION** > SEARCH FOR STRUCTURES;

Only in case of impossibility of access via the web to your reserved area, **exclusively for retired, retired or long absent staff**, it will be possible to request pre-activation by calling the Operations Center on 800.901.223 (choice of key 2, option 2).



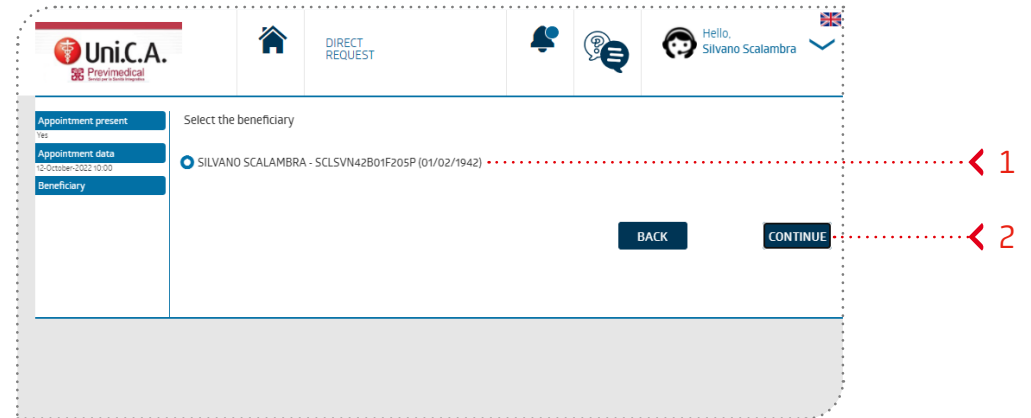
➤ **Contact the Healthcare Facility directly** to set the date and time of the appointment. Those who belong to this category of insured must report to the Healthcare Facility that they want to participate in the Uni.C.A. Prevention campaign 2022-2023. UniCredit Group Staff Assistance Fund, managed through Previmedical. To activate the services provided for in Phase 3, the Healthcare Facility will contact the Patient to agree on the date and time of the appointment.

➤ **Submit the request for authorization of the initiative by following the following instructions:**

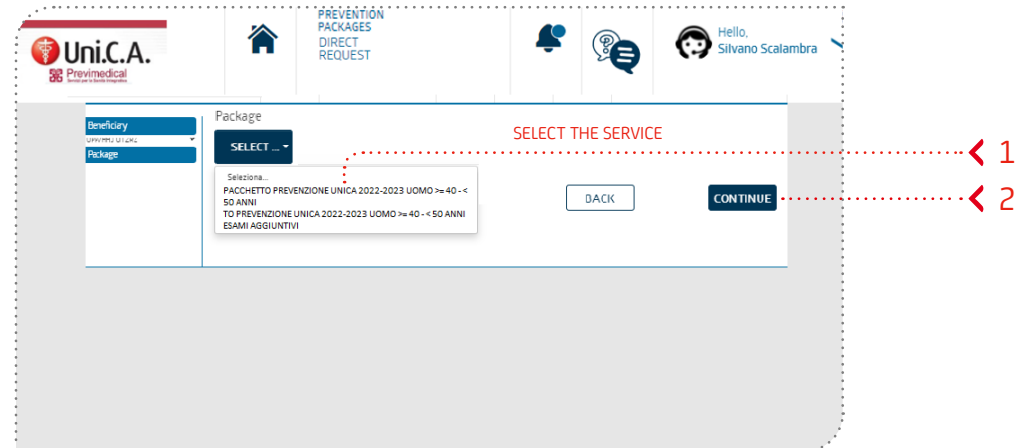
- **if Employee in service**, via My UniCredit > My Workspace > Welfare UniCredit > Uni.C.A. (icon present in the “red bar” at the top) > Your health plan > PREVENTION > PREVENTION PACKAGES 2022-2023;
- **for everyone**, through their own reserved area accessible from the website www.unica.previmedical.it - Members Area > PREVENTION > PREVENTION PACKAGES 2022-2023;
- only in case of impossibility of access via web to one’s own reserved area, **exclusively for retired, retired or long absent personnel**, it will be possible to request pre-activation by contacting the Operations Center at 800.901.223 (choice of key 2, option 2);



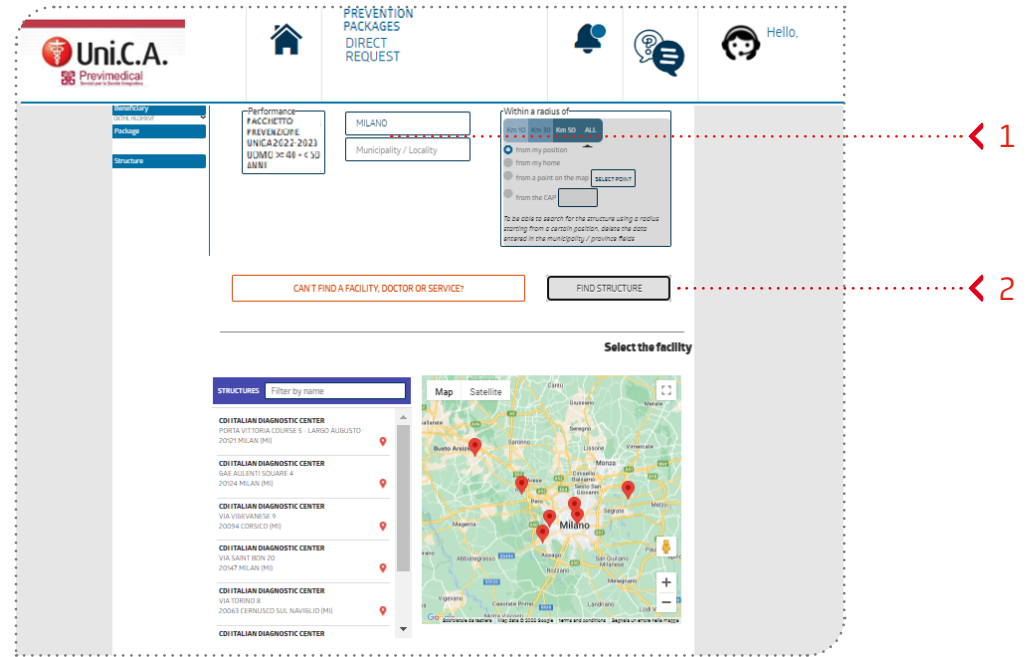
- after you have clicked on the box > PREVENTION PACKAGES 2022/2023, you can **select the beneficiary**, or who is entitled to carry out the protocols and by clicking on the **NEXT** button you will go to the next screen;



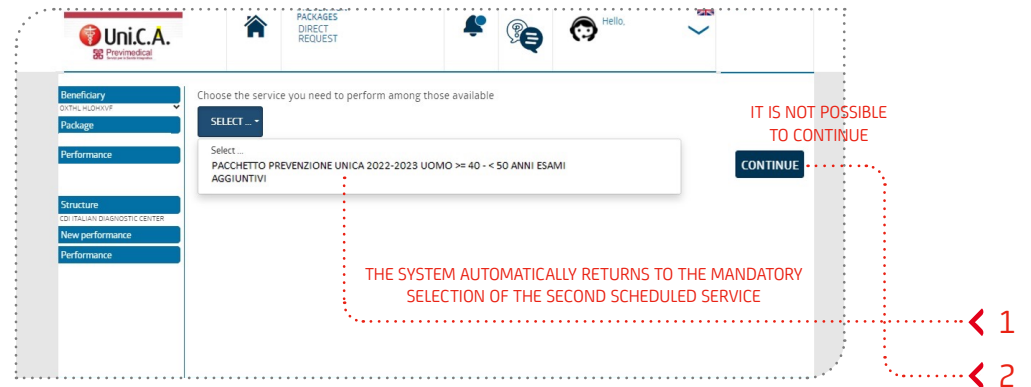
- in the next screen it will be possible to **select the Prevention, assigned according to the age group**. After selecting the prevention and clicking the **NEXT** button, **the previously selected structure will be searched**;



- after searching for and selecting the facility, by clicking on the **NEXT** button, the system automatically returns to the Prevention selection screen. This is only true if the indicated age range also contains additional ratings;



- **if additional examinations are planned**, the patient must also select the other prevention protocol, otherwise he will not be able to continue with the authorization;



- After selecting the protocol of the additional exams, you can click on the **NEXT** button which will allow you to go to the **CONTACTS** confirmation screen;

- If the Patient is unable to perform the prevention protocol after setting the appointment date and requesting authorization, he or she can request **cancellation at least 3 days before the scheduled date**; to this end, he can open a ticket (so-called Form Mail) present in his own Reserved Area or **contact the Operations Center at 800.901.223**. **It should be noted that the modification of the pre-activation for the execution of the protocol or protocols will be allowed for a maximum of 2 times**; in the event that the aforementioned 3-day notice is not respected, the Client may request the change of the appointment for the execution of the services **only once**.

The Healthcare Facility:

- will perform the services contained in the protocol or protocols provided for the Client, authorized by the Previmedical Operations Center;
 - will have the client sign the consent for the transmission of the results of cancer prevention reports (for the purpose of drafting statistical data) in an anonymous and aggregate form to Previmedical;
 - will fill in the Oncology Package Report Form following the implementation of the 2nd phase Pr
 - will deliver the report of the services performed to the Client;
- will send Previmedical an anonymous and collective numerical summary of the data requested in the form;
 - will provide the Patient with useful information for calculating the cardiovascular risk class to which it belongs, as defined in the “Heart Project” drawn up by the Ministry of Health. The Heart Project is a program of epidemiology and prevention of cerebral and cardiovascular diseases aimed at monitoring their frequency, risk factors related to them in our country and providing useful tools to prevent them. To this end, it is sufficient to fill in a simple questionnaire aimed at investigating the possible risk factors and their extent in all interested parties; together with some variables (age, sex and smoking habit) some haematochemical parameters must be known such as the total cholesterol value and its HDL “protective” fraction and blood pressure (with or without concomitant therapy). At the end it is possible to derive a score corresponding to a percentage of risk of developing cardiovascular events in the following 10 years.
